1. What are the green fees at Burgundy?

Members: Juniors/Women/Pensioners: R40 per round. Other members: R60 per round.

Juniors & Full time Students do not pay Sports Club fees. For juniors we need a copy of their birth certificate; for students we need proof of their registration for the current year.

Existing members who do not renew membership by 31 May must re-apply for membership – new membership (maybe pro-rata applies) rates and full Entrance Fee will apply.

4. How much is the Old Mutual Golf Club subscription fee?

Note: Only fully paid up members as at 30 April 2019 will be allowed to attend the AGM in May.

5. What about handicaps?

If you request this, OMGC will calculate your Burgundy handicap based on your old Mupine scores or new Burgundy scores (only to be used at Burgundy). After you have played a round of 18 holes with a marker, you enter your differential in the register. We record these scores on our system and then post your handicap in the Burgundy Handicap Register (minimum of 5 scores required before we produce a handicap).

If you do not belong to a SAGA-affiliated golf club, and you request this, OMGC will keep your big course handicap. Note however that this handicap is not recognized as SAGA-affiliated, even though OMGC utilizes the SAGA handicap formula.

6. Besides Burgundy, what other golf courses are included on the schedule of OMGC events?

OMGC has a regular monthly outing at a big course. These events offer great value for money because the green fees are fixed through Playmore Golf, and these discounts are passed onto participants. Recent courses include Milnerton, Durbanville, Bellville, Westlake, Boschenmeer etc. The Club also plays 2 rounds of Golf once a year in the family/Away weekend. Recent courses have been Langebaan, Kleinmond and Robertson.

7. How many guests can play with a member?

For all OMGC competition events, excluding major events, a member may invite 1 guest. Note that members get 1st preference up until the stipulated cut-off date; thereafter guests are included.

No guests are allowed to participate in OMGC major events at Burgundy. These events include the Summer Classic, Individual and Doubles Matchplay, etc.

8. What Club competitions can members and their guests participate in?

Saturday Burgundy competition – from 13h00

- You must enter your name in the draw (you may enter via omgolfbookings@gmail.com – your responsibility to check if entered into draw).
- You are allowed to withdraw but no later than Thursday evening prior to competition day.
- If you should withdraw after the deadline, and there are no reserves, you will have to provide a reserve or penalties are imposed.
- 18 holes (competition format varies – see fixtures)
- R20 competition fee (in addition to the green fee) for members
- R40 competition fee (in addition to the green fee) for members' guests
- You are allowed to enter one guest, but members receive first preference up to the withdrawal deadline (Thursday evening).

Monthly Big Course Outing (no Saturday Burgundy competition on weekends when there is a big course outing)

- You must enter your name in the draw (you may enter via omgolfbookings@gmail.com - your responsibility to check if entered into draw).
- You are allowed to withdraw but not later than the one week prior to the competition day.
- If you should withdraw after the deadline, and there are no reserves, you will have to provide a reserve or penalties are imposed.
- Check the fixture list for courses, dates and times – as most of these outings take place on a Sunday afternoon.
- 18 holes (competition format varies – see fixtures)
- Cost of participation (competition and green fees) is published on the fixtures and draw. Generally the fee is R270 for members and R300 for guests.
- You are allowed to enter one guest, but members receive first preference up to the withdrawal deadline (one week before).

Burgundy Major Competitions – (Paid up members only)

- You must enter your name in the draw (you may enter via omgolfbookings@gmail.com - your responsibility to check if entered into draw).
- You are allowed to withdraw but not later than the one week prior to the competition day.
- If you should withdraw after the deadline, and there are no reserves, you will have to provide a reserve or penalties are imposed.
- R70 entrance fee (in addition to green fee) – If spouse or friend attends cost of meal is R70.
- No guests of members are allowed to participate in any Major competitions.
- Most of these competitions take place on Saturday over 27 holes, but there are 2 match-play competitions (singles and doubles) that are played as arranged between the opponents as long as these matches happen by the published deadline for that round.
